Qualifications and Uses

Purpose:

The Second Church Fund Scholarship program exists in order to support members of Second Presbyterian Church in their pursuit of higher education by awarding annual college/trade school scholarships. Along with providing scholarships for furthering employment certifications.

Scholarship Type:

The SCF Scholarship(s) given are grants with no requirements for repayment.

Student Criteria:

- The student must be a student in good standing at an accredited college or university, junior college, technical college or trade school with a two-year minimum program, making satisfactory progress toward a degree or certification.
- The student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 (4.0 scale), where applicable (ie: college).
- The student and/or parent(s)/legal guardian must be a member of Second Presbyterian Church for at least one year prior to the application deadline OR the student must demonstrate service and commitment to Second Presbyterian Church.

Scholarship Uses:

The SCF Scholarship money must be used for tuition and/or room and board.

Applications:

Information and applications are available in the church office or at spenewark.org. Applications must be returned in their entirety as specified by the application to the church office by APRIL 1.

Scholarship(s) Awarded:

There will be 6 Scholarships awarded each year. The SCF Scholarship(s) given will be in the amount of \$1,500 per student. If there are more than 6 scholarship applications each year, High School and/or College/Trade School, the applications will be graded on the following scale.
